Applications are invited for nominations for 2018 edition of the UNESCO King Hamad Bin Isa Al-Khalifa Prize for the Use of Information and Communication Technologies (ICTs). The theme is “the use of innovation information and communication Technologies to ensure education for the most vulnerable groups.”

2. Eligibility

The Prize rewards people and institutions who have made a significant contribution to the creative use of information and communication technologies (ICTs) to enhance learning, teaching and overall educational performance.

3. Prize

The Prize consists of:

- (a) A Diploma; and
- (b) US \$50,000/- to be shared equally between two Prize Winners.

4. The deadline for submission to the Mauritius National Commission for UNESCO is **Wednesday 10 October 2018**.
