The aim of the prize, which was renewed by the Executive Board at its 199th session, is to reward the outstanding contributions of individuals and organizations that promote the inclusion and enhancement of the lives of persons with disabilities, using effective, innovative and inclusive application of digital solutions.

The two prize winners will be designated by the Director-General as recommended by an international jury of experts in the field. Each prize winner shall receive a sum of US \$20,000, as well as a diploma.

All applicants are invited to complete the application form enclosed, either in English or French, online at the following address: <http://en.unesco.org/prizes/digital-empowerment>. The completed forms may also be returned in paper format no later than **30 September 2018**.

Member States may propose nominations to UNESCO following consultation with their National Commissions for UNESCO and non-governmental organizations in official partnerships with the Organization.
