Eligibility criteria

Applications are now open for UK alumni who studied:

- within the last 15 years (i.e. 2003 or later), and
- enrolled at an officially **recognised** (160 institutions) or **listed** (650 institutions) UK higher education institution, and
- at degree level* or above, and
- **either at or in the UK**, for a minimum of one term or semester, **OR awarded a full UK degree level qualification** (or higher), by a recognised or listed UK HEI, **in their home country.**

*Degree level is defined as band 9 and above on the [UK NARIC band framework](#)
